I am submitting this form as a grievance. This is the Federal case of US v. Dawn Hanna Criminal Case No. 07-20355. Dawn Hanna is innocent. I am the CIA Operative, Emad Yawer (Emad Al-Yawer), involved in the case. During the discovery process, I was contacted by agent Brian Wallace, for the prosecution, and he assured me they had read my file and were aware of my involvement in working with the CIA to obtain equipment on behalf of the United States to penetrate and to over throw Saddam Hussein's regime. Believing Ms. Hanna would never be found guilty and was assured that no innocent person would be prosecuted as they were only after Saddam and his henchmen, with the prosecution's knowledge of my US involvement, I never did disclose details of the operation to Ms. Hanna. I did write a letter to Ms McQuade, later to learn she had altered my letter and compromised its validity. Being outraged by the guilty verdict and sentence, I wrote and sent, notarized letters to Judge Battani, did a phone interview with Detroit local WDIV televised special. An innocent woman is in prison serving a 6-year sentence. I solicited, Dawn Hanna, a broker, to help obtain equipment to over throw the Saddam Hussein regime by the US CIA operation and never disclosed details of the project, or the true destination of the equipment to Dawn, not even to my wife. No crime was ever committed, as it was all approved by the CIA. I am anxious to correct this grave injustice, and free Dawn Hanna. I am outraged with this outcome, all the cost in money and human lives (US and Iraqis) for freedom and democracy, while in the freedom, we have this injustice.
